Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) was developed by Universities/ Research Institutes in the United States as a self-study tool in human research ethics before commencing their research with human participants. Mahidol University subscribes this English program (3,000 US\$/year) for researcher who wish to use online self-study tool instead of attending other courses provided in Thai language. The one who complete CITI curriculum can automatically print the report (transcript) which is acceptable as any certificate of attendance of Human Research Ethics courses in MU.

The CITI Coursework Requirement Report is one of the required document (that can be used as an alternative of Certificate of Attendance of Human Research Ethics Course) when submitting research proposal for ethical approval from IRBs.
