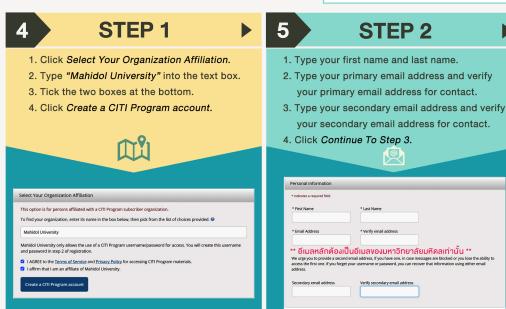


Steps to Take the CITI Program Course on Human Research Ethics

- Open Chrome or any other web browsers. O C O
- Type 🔗 https://www.citiprogram.org into the URL bar, and then click Enter.
- Click Register on the top right corner.



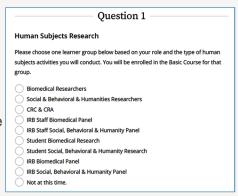






- 8 Click Yes to collect CE/CME credits (physicians doing continuing education) and click **Submit**. Click **No** if you do not need credit collecting.
- Provide information about your affiliation and set your preferred language. Then click Next.
